

TERMS & CONDITIONS

We are taking safety precautions very seriously for members interested in participating in the 2020 NAIOP Golf Outing. Due to the ban on large gatherings, NAIOP Silicon Valley has opted to offer this outing opportunity as a way for our members to enjoy a round of golf with their colleagues whom they likely haven't seen in some time. This outing will be conducted in accordance with local health department restrictions, as well as those of the club (including wearing masks when required and single riders in each cart). All registrants will be required to sign waiver to participate.

How Will It Work?

- Sequential Tee Time Format - All foursomes will have scheduled tee times between 9:50am and 12:20pm. Tee times will be scheduled every 15 minutes.
- Each golfer will have their own cart. Golf Carts will be sanitized before and after each use.
- Golfers will receive a pre-packaged boxed lunch.
- No gatherings, such as receptions or a post-event dinner, are permitted or planned.
- Golfers can arrive **no sooner** than 30 minutes prior to their tee time. Carts and range balls will not be available until 30 min prior to your scheduled tee time.
- Cinnabar Hills Golf Club requires customers to wear face masks or other CDC recommended face protection when entering the property and while directly interacting with staff or volunteers.
- Social distancing is required at all times while on premise.
- **While Golfing:**
 - Cups will have foam inserts placed in them to make ball retrieval easy, without touching the cup or flagstick.
 - Flagsticks cannot be removed for any reason.
 - There will be no bunker rakes and lies in the bunkers will be "preferred lies" and a player is permitted to place his ball.
 - Players must smooth sand with their foot as best as possible.
 - Pace of Play - Players are asked to maintain a pace of 4 hours or less.
- Once your round is completed, you are required to return the cart to the cart staging area and leave the premises as soon as possible to eliminate gathering or congregating on the property or parking lot.

Participant Expectations

- If you answer yes to any of the following questions, we ask that you do not register or cancel your current registration and stay home.
 - Within the 14 days leading up to October 29th, have you or anyone you've come in contact with tested positive for COVID-19 or were exposed to someone with COVID-19?
 - Within the 14 days leading up to October 29th, have you experienced any of the known symptoms of COVID-19 or otherwise feel unwell? Symptoms include: fever (temp = 100.4+ degrees) or chills, severe headache, muscle pain or weakness, sore throat, diarrhea, shortness of breath, and congestion.  - Within the 14 days leading up to October 29th, have you worked or volunteered in a healthcare facility or as a first responder?
 - Have you traveled out of the country in the past 30 days?
- We are encouraging everyone to wear a mask when interacting with other golfers, even while on the course.
- Each golfer must sign a COVID-19 waiver upon registration.
- Everyone is required to follow 6' distance markings and any other signage across the golf course.
- Participants are not permitted to bring in outside food or beverage. You must purchase any and all beverages and snacks from the club snack bar or the beverage cart which will be roaming the course.
- Due to COVID-19, there is no golf valet or club rental. Golfers will need to take their own clubs directly to golf carts.
- There will be no golfer onsite registration. All registration and staff interactions will take place with the clubhouse staff.
